

Cookie Policy

This website (“Website”) that belongs to Grenke Limited (“GRENKE”), uses cookies to improve and optimise user’s experience. In the terms and conditions set out below, you will find detailed information regarding what cookies are, the types of cookies used, and how to disable cookies in your browser.

General Cookies Information

Cookies are small text files, generated by the websites that you visit, which contain session data related to your visit that can subsequently be used by the website that you visited to facilitate your next visit.

The purpose of the cookies used on the present Website is as follows:

idsrv	Identify the user by his ID	GRENKE
idsrv.xsrf	Prevent Cross-Site-Request-Forgery	GRENKE
idsvr.clients	Saves the clients the user is logged in to. Currently only GO Partner	GRENKE
idsvr.session	Identify the current session. Used for logout	GRENKE
